Languages	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● All classes are taught in SPANISH ● Level required B2 or more ● Language proof certificate is not required. However, students will not be able to follow and complete courses if their level of Spanish is lower than expected.

Application	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Students will receive an email with the application form and instructions to apply. Deadlines to submit applications: ● For semester 1: September 15 to November 1 ● For semester 2: March 15 to May 1
Acceptance Letter	Students will receive an acceptance letter the following week after deadline of submission of applications.

MBA Courses	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Our MBA courses is open only to Advances Business students. ● During application process, our MBA coordinator will decide if candidates can take courses at this level. ● https://www.palermo.edu/negocios/mba/

Health Insurance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Health Insurance is mandatory. ● The student is free to obtain the insurance he/she desires. ● It is mandatory to buy a health insurance which covers evacuation & repatriation.
Spanish Classes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● We offer Spanish courses free of charge at ADVANCED level (B2/C1). ● 3-hour weekly classes. ● The Spanish course awards 4(four) credits.
Credits	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Students can take up to 5 (five) course per semester. ● Courses award 4 (four) credits each. ● One credit is one weekly hour of class attendance plus around two hours of study and homework per week, during the semester (minimum 17 weeks) including final exams. ● The way credits are transferred to your university is their decision. ● Exchange students can choose from all the available offer of courses, with the exception of thesis preparation, “pasantías” and Programa Ejecutivo.
