(Nomination should arrive before the student applies)

Academic Structure

Bachelor = 3 years
Master = 2 years

Language of instruction

Bachelor classes are taught in French and to some extent in English. The offer varies from one section to another. Master courses are mainly taught in English.

Language requirements

Based on the language of instructions of the courses, it is strongly recommended to have a B2 level in French and/or in English. No certificate is required.
