VinUniversity students come from 63 cities and provinces nationwide as well as from abroad. Studying and living in Hanoi, a thousand-year-old capital with a long history and rich culture is definitely an unforgettable experience for every student. Here the top 10 things to do in Hanoi:

1. Visit Ho Chi Minh mausoleum

Uncle Ho's mausoleum is a place of pride not only for Hanoi but also for all Vietnamese people. This is a place that all Vietnamese would visit at least once in their lifetime.

2. Explore the old quarter

The 36 streets in Hanoi's old quarter are ancient streets that still keep their rhythm of history and architecture from the 19th century. The memorable houses and street corners with many shops selling unique items have been preserved over many generations.

3. Temple of Literature

With over 1000 years of history, the Temple of Literature still retains its ancient look with architectural features from the Ly Dynasty. This is one of the most distinctive historical and cultural monuments in Hanoi.

4. Walk around Hoan Kiem Lake in the early morning

Regardless of the weather or the season, people in the capital still keep the habit of walking around Hoan Kiem Lake every early morning. Participating in sports, exercising, or just walking while chatting with friends and watching a peaceful capital behind the urban bustle are also must-dos when coming to Hanoi.

5. Watch the sunset at West Lake

The afternoon is an ideal time to watch the sunset and take a relaxing walk after a hard-working day at West Lake, certainly different from the crowded and bustling streets of Hanoi.

6. Enjoy "Bun cha"

"Bun cha" Hanoi a dish of flavorful chargrilled pork, white rice noodles, served with herbs and dipping sauce is a must-try specialty in the capital.

7. Walk on Long Bien Bridge

As a witness to the history of Hanoi for over 100 years, Long Bien Bridge is an ideal destination for art in the soul of local people. Don't miss the photo opportunities!

8. Sip on egg coffee

The uniqueness of egg coffee lays in its flavor which is not too bitter and doesn't have an egg smell. The creamy taste of the soft whisked egg yolk mixed with rich coffee will make people go from surprised to addicted.

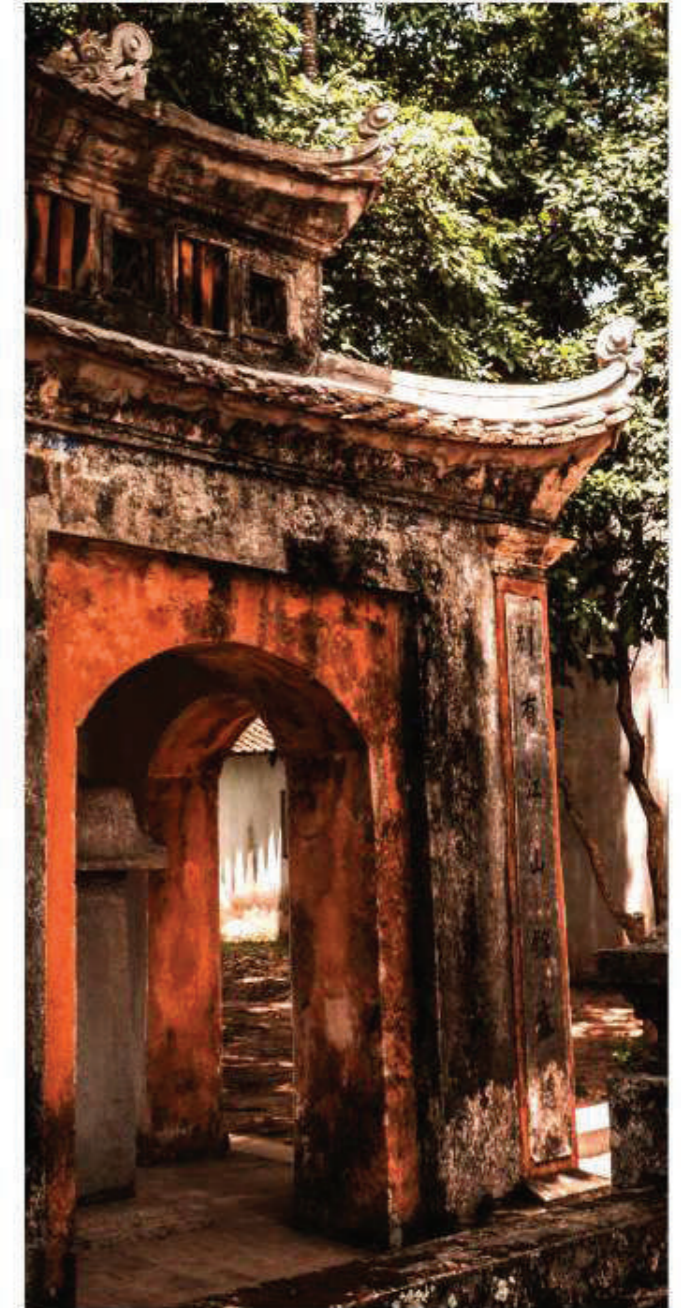
9. Hanoi St. Joseph's Cathedral

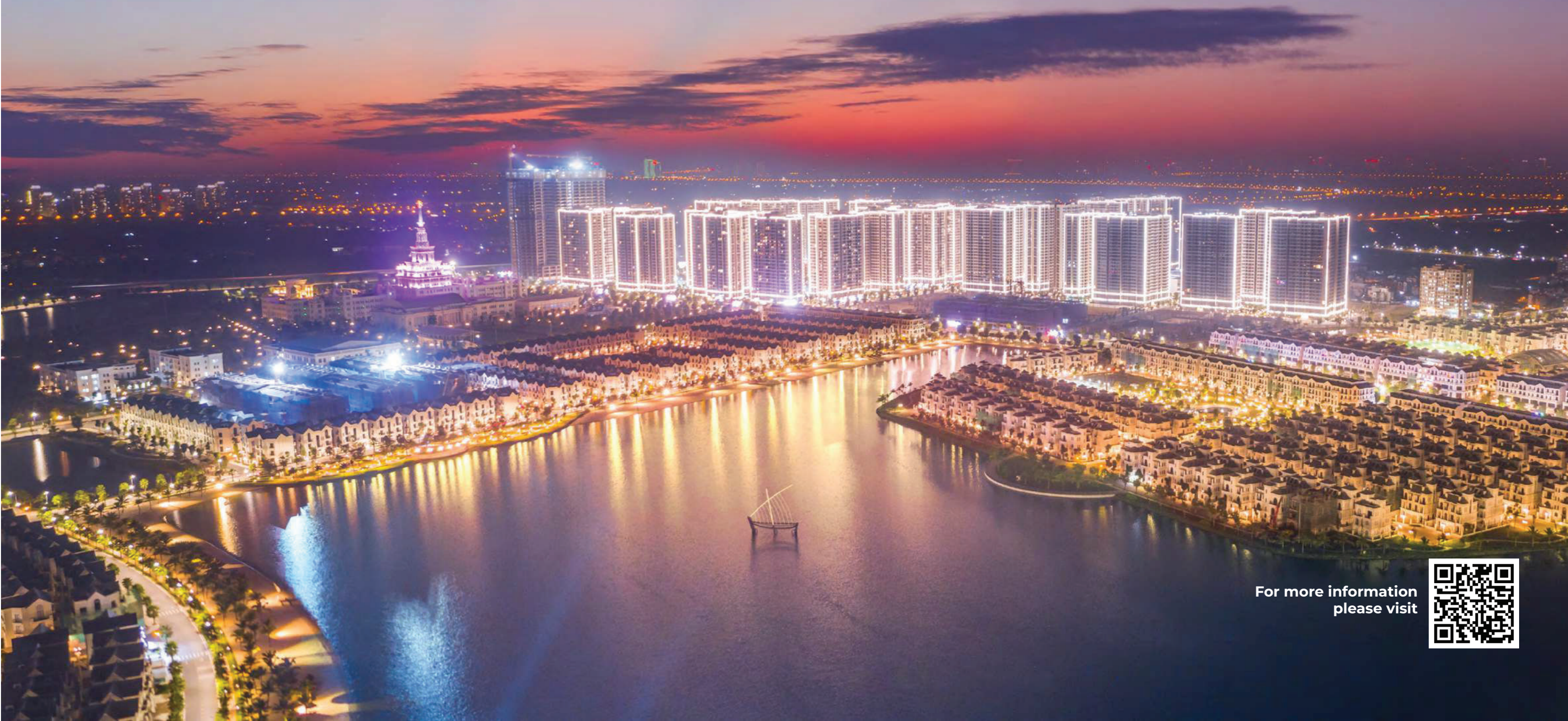

REQUIREMENT AND COURSE OVERVIEW

ENTRY LEVEL

Evidence of strong academic preparation in general and in the proposed field(s) of study; a minimum of one and a half years of continuous full-time university study at home institution; a grade point average (CGPA) is not less than 2.5 accumulatively.

AGE 18 or above

ENGLISH LEVEL

The TOEFL and IELTS are the two most frequently accepted tests for those students who come from non-official English speaking countries.

- IELTS: Minimum of 6.5 with no band score lower than 6.0
- TOEFL iBT: Minimum 79 with at least 20 for writing, 18 for speaking, 15 for reading, and 15 for listening.
- Pearson Test of English (Academic) – Minimum overall score of 58 with no communicative skills score less than 50.
- Cambridge English Certificate in Advanced English (CAE) – Minimum 176 with no skill below 169 in any component.

The detail of course registration guidance will be sent to all enrolled students within 2 weeks before the course registration period. Exchange students can select courses as long as there are slots available and they meet the prerequisite requirements. Some courses may require professor approval for enrollment.

LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION English

STUDY LOAD

The total required credits for each semester will be **at least 12 credits** and **no more than 22 credits** - A credit is equivalent to 50 hours of study for students, including taught study (contact hours), tutorials, self-managed study, experiential learning, assessments, and exams. The study load is defined in detail according to the VinUni's Academic Regulations.

ACADEMIC RECORD

The study performance of student is recorded and managed on SIS. After finishing the study, VinUni will issue the academic transcript for students. Students receive 2 free transcript copies. All transcripts are mailed to students' home universities for handling and will take about 6-8 weeks after the semester for the arrival.

GRADING SYSTEM

The University grading system is composed of letter grades with pluses and minuses. Passing grades range from A to D-; F is a fail.

TEACHING METHOD

Eschewing the traditional, didactic form of learning, VinUniversity provides a highly student centric, active & experiential forms of teaching and learning. Faculty use a variety of models suitable to drive higher order learning for the subject: from case based teaching, project based and problem based learning, group work, debates and discussions, applied projects, service and community learning and many others.

ADDITIONAL CLASSES

VinUni offers many free elective courses. Moreover, the course of Vietnamese Language is opened and specially designed for foreign students.

- **Accommodation:** ± 644 US\$/semester(shared room)
- **Deposit accommodation:** ± 172 US\$/month
- **Food:** ± 129 US\$/meal
- **Personal care:** ± 45 - 90 US\$/month
- **Basic shopping:** ± 45 US\$/month
- **Social Activities:** ± 45 US\$/month
- **Visa:** 95 US\$ for 3 – 6 month visa

HOUSING

VinUni Dorm is located inside the campus. We offer fully furnished accommodation (no kitchen) and students can share a room. Also, there are many services for residents, including Canteen (at own costs), Laundry Service, Vending Machines, Mini convenience store, Cafeteria, and so on.

Exchange students can always rent rooms outside of campus in walking distance in Vinhomes Apartment Building.

HEALTH & TRAVEL INSURANCE

Health insurance fee for international student is a compulsory surcharge which is paid by the students to cover the appropriate health insurance package during their study period at VinUniversity.

On average, health insurance fee for international students is about 5,700,000.00 VND/- year/student (equivalent US\$250). Fee may vary from year to year depending on the policy of the insurance providers.

STUDY PERMIT & ENTRY VISA

For a short term study/exchange study period in Vietnam, incoming exchange students need student exchange visa/residence permit. VinUni will provide inbound exchange students with necessary supporting documents for them to apply for the visa.

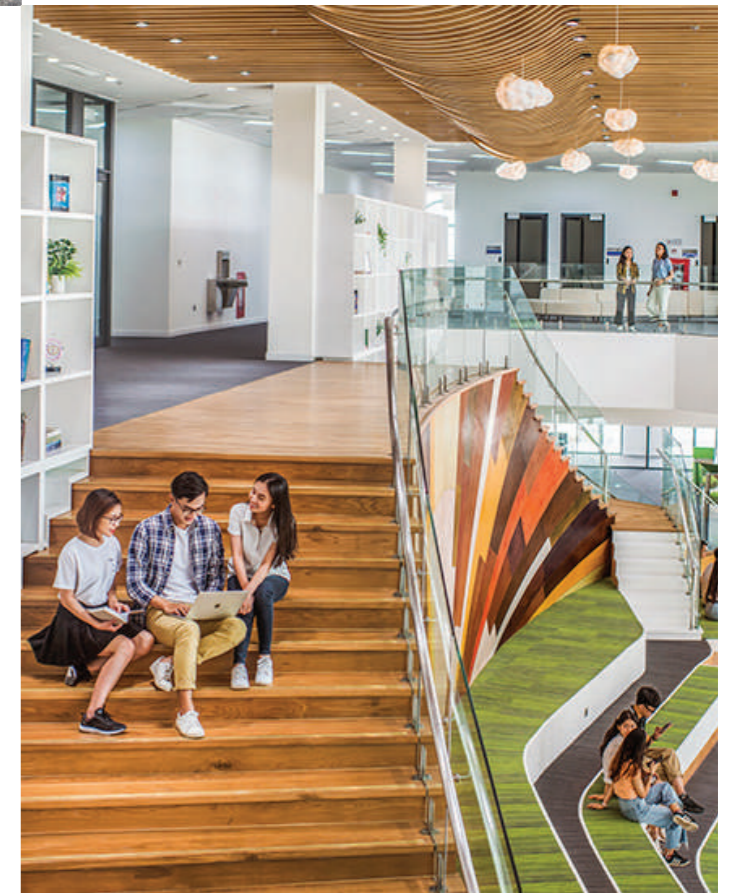
